

Land Labs

Arrive at school by 8:00 A.M. the first day, and return to the school by 11:30 A.M. for Land Labs 1 and 3, and by 3:30 P.M. for Land Lab 2

Description:

- Pre-shopping for supplies (Office Administrator will direct)
- Pre-shopping for snacks (Office Administrator will direct)
- Drive your vehicle with assigned students to and from Triangle Y (Oracle, AZ)
- On day of departure, help pack vehicles with supplies and attend parent meeting
- Sleep in student cabins
- Help in running eco challenges, activities, and other special events
- Help supervise free-time and meal time and set up snacks
- Other responsibilities will be assigned during the Land Lab
