

Lunch Duty

The perfect opportunity to spend a little extra time with your child and their classmates during the school day. The teachers truly appreciate your help with this as it gives them uninterrupted time to meet together as a team.

Dates and Times Needed:

Monday, Tuesday and Thursday from 12:30-1:00 P.M.

Wednesday and Friday from 12:30 – 1:20.

We only need one parent per day. Ultimately we would like to schedule this at the beginning of the year, or at the start of each month. But, if you find you have a spare lunch at the last minute, give the office a call. Some people sign up for the same day each week. Some people sign up for one week a year. Whatever works in your schedule is appreciated.

Description:

- Monitor students during first 10 minutes while they eat their lunch making sure they remain seated and behave appropriately
- After the first 10 minutes, you may excuse those students that have cleaned their space
- Chaperone students on playground area
- Some students may elect to remain in the picnic table area to do quiet work such as reading, etc.
- Inform students when lunch is over to ensure that everyone returns to class
- At end of year, update this form for next year's Lunch Chaperone

Requirements:

- A fingerprint clearance card is needed

- The first time you do this one of the staff will be on hand to answer questions and go over rules and expectations for lunch/recess behavior
