

# STUDENT CONDUCT

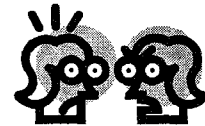
**At Hall's Prairie students are expected to:**

- \* act in a manner which does not infringe on the rights of others or endanger the health and well-being of themselves or others
- \* treat themselves and others with dignity and respect
- \* become actively and productively involved in their own learning
- \* arrive at school on time
- \* respect the property of the school and others
- \* wear clothing appropriate to a school setting

**Positive Behaviour:** Good choices by students is recognized and reinforced both verbally and with Hall's Prairie appreciation" tickets.

**Unacceptable Behaviour:** Unacceptable behaviour can consist of, but is not limited to the following and will be dealt with appropriately:

- \* fighting
- \* swearing
- \* stealing
- \* bullying
- \* defiance of authority
- \* insolence or rudeness



**Zero Tolerance Offences:** A zero tolerance offence is any behaviour that has the potential to, or does, seriously endanger the personal safety of one's self or others. Bullying, smoking, use of drugs or alcohol, possession of weapons, or acts of violence are examples of zero tolerance offences. Zero tolerance means that offences will not be ignored or rated lightly. Zero tolerance offences come in degrees of severity and may result in the out-of-school suspension of the student.
