Grizzly Late Work Policy

- ◆ **DEFINITION OF LATE WORK:** Any assignment that is completed/turned in after the teacher has already collected that assignment in class is considered late. All assignments must be turned in. All late assignments must be completed within a week of the original due date and will receive a "Z" (zero) in the grade book until they have been turned in.
- ◆ Late assignments will rarely (if ever) receive full credit and the total score may be reduced by as much as 50%. No credit will be given for assignments that are more than a week overdue, but the expectation is that these assignments will still be completed. Parents will be contacted if there is a regular problem with turning in assignments on time.
- ◆ In the case of excused student absences, the due date for assignments that were missed will be extended for a reasonable amount of time so that the student can get caught up. Students are encouraged not to miss school unless absolutely necessary. Frequent absences will certainly take a toll on a student's grades. If a student misses more than one day of school, homework should be picked up by a family member so that the student can work on it at home. Please call the school (or e-mail teachers) several hours ahead of time to give them enough time to gather these assignments and bring them to the office to be picked up.
- ◆ Although the above is our general policy, teachers retain the right to adjust this policy on an individual basis at our professional discretion.
