## WAYS TO STUDY

1. Always use homophones correctly in a sentence. (their, there, they're- its, it's etc...)

Choose a way to study all 10 words from the list below.

1. Look, cover, spell, check method. 1, look at the word 2, close your eyes and see the word 3, write the word from memory (No copying) 4, check and see if you spelled it correctly. **Do this five times.**
2. Pyramid writing:

3. Rainbow writing: 1. Write each word with pencil. 2. Go over each letter with 3 different colors.  
Sort words: sort words three different ways. Write down the lists: by sounds, syllables, prefix, suffix, meaning, etc...
4. Word family: Choose a word, by changing one letter make a new word. Continue with as many words as you can think of: said, paid, raid, maid etc... (Make 5 new words)
5. Use spelling words to create as few sentences as possible.
6. Create a crossword puzzle using your spelling words on graph paper or [www.puzzlemaker.com](http://www.puzzlemaker.com) and create a key.
7. Sort the words in three categories such as, syllables, sounds, prefix/suffix/root, etc... Make a list of words for each category.
8. Write words in alphabetical order. Then write the words in backward alphabetical order (start with the end of the alphabet.)
9. Colored writing: write consonants in one color and vowels in a different color.
10. Write a poem using your spelling words
11. Use your spelling words to create a comic strip.
12. Cut your spelling words out of a magazine or newspaper and glue to paper.
13. Use a picture or photo and write a story using your spelling words.
