SANGER ACADEMY CHARTER SCHOOL BEARS AGAINST BULLYING

Bullying is when someone repeatedly and on purpose says or does mean or hurtful things to another person who has a hard time defending himself or herself. The students of Sanger Academy will take a stand against bullying by following all of the following four rules:

1. We will not bully others.
2. We will try to help students who are being bullied. (*immediately get an adult, tell the bully to stop, be a friend to the person who is being bullied, etc*)
3. We will try to include students who are left out. (do not purposefully leave a person out of an activity or group, do not purposefully ignore another student, do invite others to join an activity. Etc.)
4. If we know that somebody is being bullied, we will tell an adult at school **AND** an adult at home. (tell any adult on campus-they can help!)

FLU NOTICE AND INFORMATION

The Flu can easily be spread from person to person, therefore, we are taking steps to reduce the spread of flu in our school district. Here are a few things that we will be encouraging our students and yourself to do to help:

- Teach your children to wash their hands.
- Teach your children not to share personal items.
