

What are Transition Services?

Transition Services are a coordinated set of activities for a student designed with an outcome-oriented process that promotes movement from school to post-school activities. This may include, but is not limited to:

- ⇒ **Postsecondary Education**
- ⇒ **Vocational/ Job training**
- ⇒ **Integrated Employment**
- ⇒ **Independent Living**
- ⇒ **Community Participation**

The coordinated set of activities must be based on individual student needs taking into account the student's preferences and interests.

Transition Services are defined in the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA) section 300.18.
