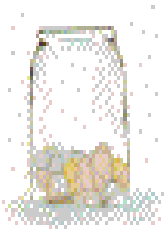


“Mystery” Box



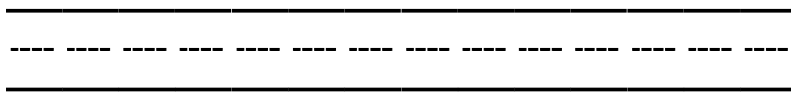

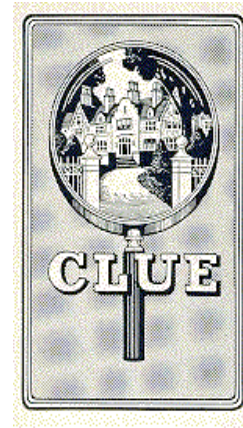
Example: If you have a toy block in the jar.
