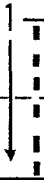

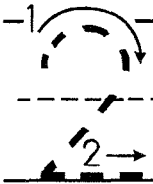
1. Write your name using the correctly letter formation.

3. Trace each numeral from 0 to 9 and practice each poem as you write each number.



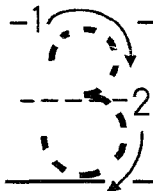
Around we go.



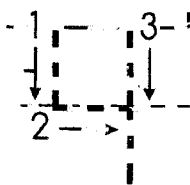
One is fun.



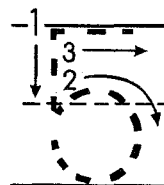
Around and back on the railroad track.



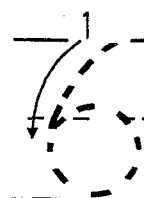
Around a tree and around a tree. That's the way to make a three.



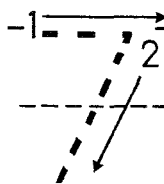
Down and over and down some more. That's the way to make a four.



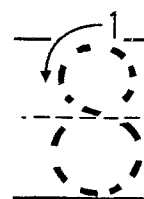
Fat old five goes down, around and put a hat on top.



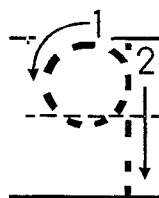
Roll a hoop and make a loop.
