



Today we worked on the concept of pairs. We matched and counted pairs of colored sticks and/or earrings.

- He/She understands the concept of pairs and was able to count the number of pairs correctly.
- He/She needs practice matching and counting the number of pairs. Have your child help you sort your family's socks. This activity will help your child learn to sort objects by color and by size. After your socks are dried, ask your child to sort all the socks into pairs. Afterwards, count the total number of pairs matched. When the sorting and counting is completed, have your child put his or her socks away.
