

## STUDENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS for CLUBS, EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES & FIELD TRIPS

ENTERING 9 <sup>TH</sup> GRADERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ NO GPA requirement 1<sup>st</sup> 18 weeks</li> </ul>
DAY FIELD TRIPS/CLUBS/ACTIVITIES      GRADES 9-12	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Cumulative GPA of 2.0</li> <li>▪ No grade of "F" in any class</li> <li>▪ No obligations and/or unserved detentions</li> <li>▪ Not permitted to participate while suspended</li> <li>▪ May not be absent from school on the day of the activity. Will be sent home if attends activity</li> </ul>
OVERNIGHT FIELD TRIPS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Cumulative GPA of 2.0 in <i>each</i> class</li> <li>▪ No more than a total of 30 hours (or 5 absences) per 18 weeks</li> <li>▪ Maximum 1 detention each 18 weeks</li> <li>▪ No obligations such as textbook fines and/or unserved detentions</li> <li>▪ No suspensions during school year</li> </ul>
OVERNIGHT FIELD TRIPS IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO FCAT TESTING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Must meet the same criteria as for an overnight field trip (see above)</li> <li>▪ Must have scored level 3 or above in both reading and math on the previous year's FCAT</li> </ul>
DISCIPLINE & NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY (NHS)  <i>County and national NHS policies will be followed regarding cases of dismissal from NHS.</i>	<p>Students are assumed to be of good character unless there is documentation of disciplinary action taken by the school, community or state for serious or persistent misconduct on the part of the student. Documentation by the school consists of administrative referral and parent contact. Students whose records contain such documentation may be denied acceptance into NHS or may be dismissed from NHS pending a hearing.</p>
