PROFESSIONAL CAREER FAIR & EXPO!

February 15th 2012 - ALL TECHNICAL PROGRAMS

The Professional Career Fair & Expo is scheduled. On **Wednesday, February 15th**, students will prepare a table/booth on the Patio showcasing their accomplishments in their Technical Program. The Expo will be held from **9:00AM - 11:00AM with set up from 8:30 - 8:55AM** and breakdown immediately following 11:00AM. Professional dress or tech specific uniform is required for the Career Fair & Expo.

Student teams will be assigned by the technical teacher. The expectation is that you all will work together and will share responsibilities for the table set up and presentation.

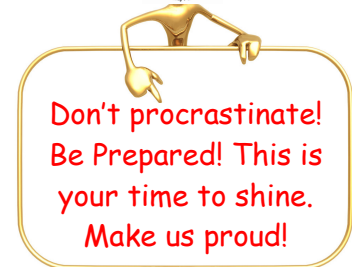
Student Presentation and Handout Requirements.... *all materials must be completed prior to February 15th.*

Students will create a:

1. Professional Visual Presentation - Computerized or a Board Display as a group
2. Professional, *informative and attractive* one page handout outlining the Technical Program of study. (Do not cut and paste from ATC's website) - Each senior will create their own handout.

The handout should include the following: *(You should plan to have 30 copies (do not need to be in color) available for distribution to Advisory Members, District Personnel Industry Professionals, ATC Staff and Parents)*

1. Technical Program Certificate requirements
2. Industry Credentials-at ATC and beyond
3. Job Opportunities locally and nationally with salary ranges
4. College/University Degrees related to field of study
5. Possibilities for multiple career paths related to technical program
6. Additional post-secondary training for high skill/high wage options
7. Full name of student author, on the bottom of the handout
 - a. **Nothing** should be handwritten on your handout

- Presentation grades will be determined by Technical teachers and counted in those classes.
- Handout grades will be calculated by Ms. Petrill/ Mrs. Leider and counted in both of your 2nd semester high school classes. HS and Tech teachers will receive a copy of the rubric outlining your grade.
- Health Students: All four (4) of your second semester high school teachers will receive your handout grade. HS teachers will receive a copy of the rubric outlining your grade.
