EXPECTATIONS

1. Be courteous to everyone, and respect peers, teacher, their property, and the school's property.
2. Be on time to class and prepared to work when the bell rings.
3. Use appropriate language.
4. Come prepared (with a sharpened pencil, paper, notebook, folder, assignment, and a willing attitude). If you do not have your mechanical pencils, please be sure to sharpen or borrow a pencil before the class begins. The same goes for other supplies.
5. Stay on task: Refrain from personal conversation/contact during class, and follow directions.
6. Resolve conflicts in a non-aggressive manner.
7. Refrain from eating or chewing gum in the classroom.
8. Turn off cell phones, pagers, music players, etc., and keep them out of sight.
9. Raise your hand and ask permission if you need to get up for some reason.
10. Raise your hand to ask a question or to make a comment.
11. Pick up any paper that falls on the ground around your desk.
12. Do not throw any paper or objects.

NEGATIVE CONSEQUENCES WHEN RULES ARE BROKEN

*Listed in order of severity

1. Warning and Redirection
2. "Character Trait Lesson"
3. Reissue character trait lesson-parent contacted-detention assigned
4. Referral to the office.

*Severe disruption (defiance, profanity toward teacher, etc.)—immediate referral to office

POSITIVE CONSEQUENCES WHEN RULES ARE OBEYED

1. More success in school
2. Positive comment on report card

TARDY POLICY

1. First Warning
2. Second Warning
3. Detention

*Excessive tardiness will result in a referral to the office
