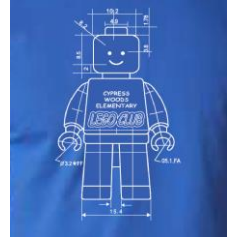

Lego Club is an after school club that provides students with a fun environment fostering creativity, problem-solving, and hands-on engineering. Each student will receive a Lego board to use during the club. They will be able to keep their creations to build upon week after week!



The club meets weekly January through April. The class size is limited to 24 students (approx. 6 from each grade). Placement in the club will be determined via lottery. Students who were not able to participate in an afterschool club during the 2016-17 school year will be given priority.

Lego Club is led by volunteers!! The club must have 3 parent volunteers per week for it to run effectively for all students! Parents are required to sign up for 2 volunteer dates prior to club kick-off date of January 25. Volunteers can be parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles, etc. Failure to sign up for volunteer dates before the deadline will result in your child's removal from the club. You must be a registered volunteer with Pinellas County Schools. If your child gets into the club, at that time you will be emailed instructions on how to register as a volunteer and will need to complete registration immediately or re-activate if you are already a volunteer.

Please return registration form by January 9. The lottery will then be held and you will be informed via email if your child was selected for Spring Semester. At that time, you will also receive a link asking you to sign up for 2 volunteer dates.

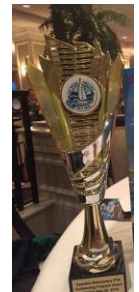

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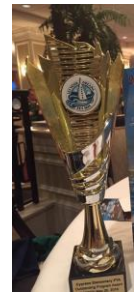
