**BE THERE CAMPAIGN**

On Wednesday, November 4, 2009, the Muscogee County School District launched the *Be There* campaign during the 5:30 p.m. newscast at the WTVM (Channel 9) television studio. *Be There* is a multi-media, national, parent involvement campaign that is sweeping the country. It is not a program or curriculum. It is a campaign designed to inspire parents to be engaged and involved in their child's education and daily learning experiences. The campaign focuses on little reminders that teachable moments are all around us, even for those parents whose schedules may not permit them to be at a school event or extra-curricular activity. We want to inspire parents to make ordinary moments extraordinary by encouraging you to engage with your children during their daily routines. By doing so, we hope to make you aware that teachable moments are everywhere.

The goal is to have all schools participate. Each school has been assigned a week to have a parent/child interview to share their teachable moment. We plan to feature one teachable moment (parent/child) from every school over the course of a year. In the 5:30 p.m. newscast, our media partner, WTVM (Channel 9), will feature a *Be There* teachable moment two Wednesdays per month.

Parents who wish to participate should complete and submit a *Be There* entry form. A copy is attached to this Friday Flyer. Parents can also access the entry form on-line, print, and submit to Eagle Ridge. The winner will be selected by Joanna Culbreth, principal, who will notify the parents that they have been selected to share their *Be There* teachable moment. Mrs. Culbreth will also notify MCSD Communications who will be responsible for arranging an interview date and time for the parent with WTVM.
