The Eighth Grade is starting off the year with some intensive color theory, but we never want our student to walk away empty handed. This art project you can actually wear out of class!

Starting with an overview of the "color wheel," students will learn about some of the unique relationships between colors and ways to use color in images. Using magazines, students will create collages demonstrating their new color knowledge, and those collages will then be turned into buttons that students can pin, becoming walking works of art!
