**Call To Order:**

**Minutes:**

The minutes from January 6 general meeting were reviewed and approved.

**Director's Report:**

- Mr. Adams reported that 10 students and 1 alternate made it to state, 2 orchestra/ 6 band and 2 jazz band. State will be February 26-28 in Wichita.
- Masterworks concert was well attended and the reception was beautiful.
- Mr. Adams introduced Nick Howe our student teacher, Olathe East graduate and currently at UMKC.
- Due to the budget the District will not be buying frumpets for next year. No new instruments district wide. Mr. Adams is not sure if SM South will still be able to purchase what they had agreed to either.

**Vice President's Report:**

- Nancy Brandt reported the last sign ups for Senior Reception, Silent Auction and Evening of Jazz will be passed around.
- Names are needed for the nominating committee; they will be announced at the March meeting.
- Royal's ticket vouchers will be sold again this year. The band will be selling 500, down from 750 last year. There are 350 tickets selling for \$12 each, they were purchased at \$7 and have a face value of \$16. Another 150 tickets will for sale at \$17, purchased for \$10 and valued at \$26. It was agreed the sale of tickets would start after cookie dough (2/6) and before spring break (3/13). Would like to tie in a Royals game with band camp – possibly Friday August 8.
- Decision on what the profits would be earmarked for was tabled until next meeting

**Treasurer's Report:**

- Becky Meschke presented the treasurers report. Still finalizing travel fund
- The beginning balance of the checking account was adjusted by \$585.00 due to a double entry in spirit wear.
- The balance sheet dated February 02, 2009 shows the checking account detail ending balance was \$25,556 and total net income over expense was \$1,435.

**Committee Reports:**

Flower Sales-Coline Sutherland reported the need for volunteers next week to sell flowers during school and Tuesday 2/10 evening to prepare the flowers. A motioned was made by Linda Batrick to increase the price per stem from \$1.50 to \$2.00, motioned was approved.

Cookie Dough- Karen Winney had emailed a request for volunteers to collect Monday on February 5 during band classes.

Garage Sales- Cindy Smith reported they are using mysignup.com to collect volunteer names. They will be making flyers for the neighborhood as it gets closer. She asked if students could volunteer the day of the sales to advertise/ play instruments on the street corner. New this year will be a section of formal wear. Mr. Adams reminded us that we need to take down all the sign after the sale is over.
