Dear Family Member:

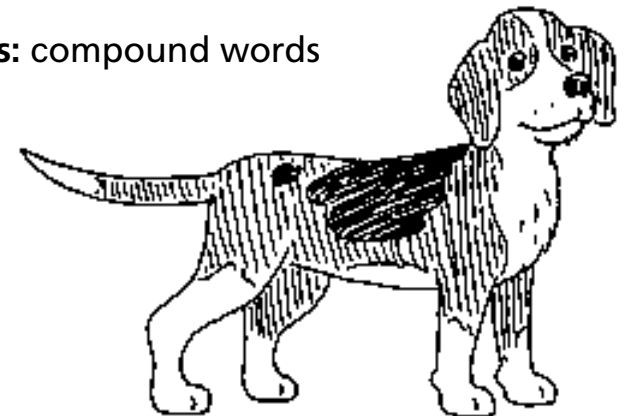
