Please assist your child in conducting the interview, However the student should do most of the work.

This is the assignment.

1. Using the Palm take a 2 or 3 pictures of the interviewee.

2. Ask these questions. Information can be entered into the Palm using any method your child knows on questions a,b,c, and d. Notepad, Memo, keyboard, or stylus.

a. What is your name and when and where were you born?

b. Where did you grow up in Louisiana?

c. How was life different then from today?

d. What are some of the customs and traditions your family shared?

e. What is the best memory of a custom or tradition

of your childhood? Child should use the voice recorder for this question. PARENT SHOULD ALSO TAKE NOTES FOR THIS QUESTION IN CASE THE RECORDING DOESN'T COME OUT GOOD.
