Writing focus is on selecting story ideas, developing a story and using details.

Spelling words focus on the long e sound spelled with "ea" or "ee."

Math-We will be working on writing number models, determining value of digits in numbers, determining the rule and continuing a pattern.

Social Studies-The students did a nice job researching their chosen symbol and presenting the information to the class. This week we will be reading from our Missouri Communities Studies Weekly social studies paper.

This Week's BIST TIP-Early Intervention: How many times do you ask your child to clean their room before you see results? We expect children to follow directions the first time they are given. If a child is redirected and then continues to act out, we may have let the misbehavior go too long! To avoid anger from the student or adult, we need to set clear boundaries and help children understand we have high expectations. With BIST, a child is given one warning for their misbehavior when the misbehavior first occurs. If the misbehavior happens again, the child is moved to a place where they can be safe.
