This Week's BIST TIP-Calm tone: What do you mean "calm tone?" If I've asked a student to do something for the ump-teenth time, I'm far from calm! We know from experience, we are better listeners and problem solvers when we are calm. So if you find your tone is not calm, it is okay to take some time for yourself to relax before talking with the child. Stop, relax, think . . . and then problem solve. You are your child's best role model!
