Reading Being able to summarize what has been read is important and we are continuing to work on this skill. Many students are very good at retelling the story but we are focusing on the main and most important events in the story. **Please be sure your child is reading at least 20 minutes a night and completing their reading log.**

Writing We are continuing with working on the beginning of our stories. Students have selected a story to publish and will finish with this assignment by Thursday.

Spelling We are back to our regular schedule....our test will be this Friday. This week we will take a multiple choice test instead of writing out the spelling words.

Math-Our math unit is continuing with determining the area and perimeter of objects. Most recently students were given the perimeter of a rectangle and had to determine possible measurements for the four sides. This has proved a little tricky for some and we will continue to practice.

Halloween Party is this Friday at 2:30. Students may bring a costume to school and change into their costume after 2nd recess. Please make sure your child can put on their own costume. I also ask that your child not bring any make-up, fake blood, swords, knives, etc. to school.

This Week's BIST TIP-Sometimes a child may need more time to calm down and think than just a "rethink" allows. If this is the case, there is a designated **safe seat** in your child's classroom for calming down and problem-solving. Your child may choose to go on his own or may be asked by an adult to go to the safe seat in his/her classroom. As part of the problem-solving process, a child may be asked to fill out a Think Sheet. A Think Sheet allows the child to **reflect** on their behavior and be **accountable** for their actions.
