Participants (age range 7-11) will be placed in a specific social skills group best suited to meet their needs following an intake screening by the facilitator.

Our goal is to help kids feel good about themselves as they learn to interact and be with other people in a variety of situations.

Our program will include games, modeling, and specific lesson plans to learn targeted skills. *Including:*

- greeting new people and friends
- establishing and maintaining friendships
- sharing during play
- turn taking during play
- understanding the feelings of others
- answering questions when someone speaks to you
- making eye contact when speaking to people
- cleaning up our toys at the end of the play date
- saying goodbye and thank you
