

An Announcement From Mr. Gaskell...

On Monday, November 2, students will be issued their ID badge and a lanyard during their lunch. The ID is to be worn effective immediately. Students will have the choice of attaching the lanyard or attaching the clip on the ID to a place on their person but it is advised that they take a lanyard. The lanyards are “breakaway.” The only requirement is that IDs are to be worn daily and visible on every student. Each student will need to attach the lanyard when they receive the ID and lanyard at lunch.

If a student forgets their ID, they will be given a one-day pass to get a temporary ID sticker from the grade level office. While taking attendance, period 1 teachers will direct any student who may have forgotten their ID to the grade level office to pick up their temporary sticker. If a student forgets an ID for a second consecutive day, they will be required to get a new ID. The first back up is free and after that, students must pay the replacement cost of \$5 for a new ID each time one is to get replaced. Students will sign off that they have received their ID, which endorses that they have received it, and that it is an accurate name and picture.

I know that everyone joins me in the excitement of making our school an even more secure environment for all and in that spirit, I ask everyone, including staff to remember to wear their ID daily.
