Procedures

-Entering the classroom

- Please wait quietly in the hallway until the class before yours has left the room.

- Getting to work

- Quietly find your seat and check the board for an agenda and instructions. Silently, on your own, open your binder to a clean page, write your name, class, date at the top and the agenda for the day. Begin work right away on the first daily task.

- Participating in class

- Please raise your hand if you have a questions, comment, or story. Only one person talks at a time.

- Passing in assignments

- All assignments are to be passed into your class basket on the due date – during class. If you have an incomplete assignment you will be attending the lunchtime assignment completion area.

- When you finish your work early:

- Read over your class notes, finish outstanding assignments, and organize your binder, and then you may work on bonus work or homework from other classes.

- Bathroom

- Please make sure you use the bathroom before you come to class. If it is absolutely necessary ask Miss. Creaser, then sign out. Only one student out at one time.

-End of Class

- Keep your binders open and remain at your seats until the teacher dismisses you. The bell does not dismiss the class. Make sure the area around your seat is clean.
