

25 Book Club Standards by Grade

Kindergarten

Picture books are main source of books.
Being read to counts towards the students book tally.
A literature response sheet will be completed in class for each of the 25 books.
A literature response folder will be used to keep track of responses.

Grade 1

Books on levels A to J constitute a standard book.
Picture books count towards the student's book tally.
One chapter of a chapter book counts as a book.
Each book read to the class is counted as a book.
Student logs and a 25 book chart record completion.

Grade 2

Any book that is at the student's independent reading level is accepted as a standard book.
Books read as a class activity count as a book.
To gauge completion of a book students keep reading response journals, take accelerated reader tests, and complete in-class literature projects of book reports.
Student logs and a 25 book chart record completion.

Grade 3

A standard book is based on the student's reading level and each book, article, etc. is approved based on the student's ability.
Books read aloud in class counts if a report or response is completed about the book.
Accelerated Reader test with a grade of 70% or better and book reports are used to gauge book completion and progress towards the 25 book standard.

Grade 4

Chapter books with at least 100 pages are accepted as a book.
5 articles are equivalent to one book.
Book completion is gauged by using accelerated reader test, reading response journals, and book reports.
The 25 book club chart, a private chart within the room, and a running record of teacher read books tally book completion.

Grade 5

Books of at least 100 pages are accepted as a book.
Any book read aloud to the class is counted as a book.
Short book report forms are required for each book to be counted towards the 25 book club.
Accelerated Reader tests are used to gauge book completion.

Special Education

A book with at least 10 pages that they can read independently counts as a book.
Material that they can read 90% of the text (10 finger rule) is accepted as a book.
Being read aloud to counts towards the student's book tally
Completed curriculum assignments are used to gauge completion towards the progress of 25 books.
