Description: The concept of friendship often means something different to children with special needs than it does to others. During this presentation, the concept of friendship during different stages of development will be discussed, followed by ways to motivate our children to want to master these steps. Barbara Cooper is a psychotherapist and registered board certified art therapist with over 25 years' experience treating both children and adults. She is one of the co-directors of SuperKids, an 11 year old therapeutic program that provides social thinking/skills programs for children ages 4-20. Through their *Social Skills 911* workshops, Barbara and the SuperKids team train school personnel, social workers and psychologists nationally. In addition, by tailoring their seminars to meet the needs of a particular district, they train teachers, paraprofessionals and psycho-social staff. Barbara is a co-author of *Knowing Yourself, Knowing Others: Activities that Teach Social Sense* and *The Social Success Workbook*. In addition Barbara frequently speaks to parent groups and offers individual parent coaching at four SuperKids locations.
