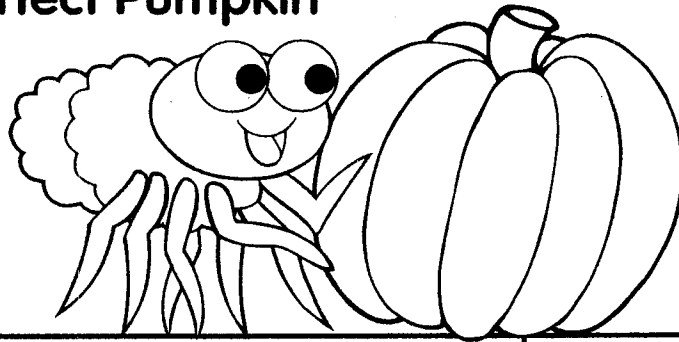
- Play a card game with your child.
