The following items are the menu you can choose from. You must complete at least TWO assignments before the unit exam.

<p>1.) Create a timeline <u>OR</u> a flow chart for the events of the French Revolution. Your timeline or chart must have accurate dates and events and it needs to have correct spelling.</p>	<p>2.) Pick an estate and write 3 paragraphs from that point of view about the events of the revolution. Make sure to include whether or not you are for or against the revolution. Remember that each paragraph must be 5 sentences long.</p>	<p>3.) Create a paper chain of events that links the enlightenment ideas to the revolution. Remember to write clearly enough so we can read it and to make sure that all events and thinkers are included.</p>
<p>4.) Create a comic strip of the people and events in the French Revolution to summarize the beginning, middle, and end of the revolution. Be colorful and creative!</p>	<p>5.) Create propaganda about the French Revolution. It can be a poster, song, newspaper advertisement or article. Be prepared to share this with the class.</p>	<p>6.) Find a political cartoon that discusses the French Revolution. Explain the cartoon and connect it to the material we have learned in class.</p>
