

# OLD TESTAMENT PROJECT 1.1

## SALVATION HISTORY PRESENTATION

Having a good grasp of Salvation History is crucial to understanding the biblical text. We have gone over a brief outline of it in class and you have had a quiz on it. Now, your task is to **ILLUSTRATE** Salvation History. Yes that is correct. Get your creative juices in gear and come up with a project that reflects your understanding of how God is working in our lives through ACTUAL HISTORICAL events and people.

You may make a PowerPoint, a Slideshow, a Story Board, a Book, Scrapbook, a Comic Book, a Timeline or a Poster. Whatever you choose YOU MUST use PICTURES. YOU MUST NOT simply re-write "A Sprint Through Salvation History." Rather your best bet is to use captions and pictures. You may draw or use clipart if you make a poster. The main goal of the project is for you to learn the events and major players of Salvation History. Short phrases and captions are best. Do not write long paragraphs.

Work from the document "A Sprint Through Salvation History" and the Timeline in your CYB. Be sure you cover all 8 sections, plus Biblical Prehistory, that are written about in "A Sprint Through Salvation History."

Project is Due, September 21, 2009, do not wait until the last minute. Do a little bit at a time. If you try to do this all at once, I guarantee most of you will burn out and get frustrated and overwhelmed.

Do not attempt to be LITERAL – be creative! Creativity, effort, display of understanding and neatness will all be part of your grade. Imagine you have to present your work in front of a group to explain Salvation History in a way that is interesting and fun.
