Principal's Message

We are finally organized!! After six weeks of uncertainty we have our full compliment of teachers with the addition of M. Daniel Lord. We are very pleased to have M. Lord join us - he has a very positive attitude and has settled in very quickly.

Thank you to all parents for their patience through all the uncertainty.

I have received a number of phone calls and e-mails regarding the instrumental music program this year. As you are aware, we do not have a music teacher in the school due to maternity leave. I was able to organize an alternative option through Partners in the Community. This is a Board-sanctioned group of professional musicians who will come to the school once or twice a week and give lessons to groups of students. Students will be grouped by instrument and will receive individualized programming.

A form was sent home to all parents requesting a \$25 cheque made out to LDSB to cover the cost of a book and the lessons. On that form was listed the instrument options if you wished to rent an instrument and the cost. A second form was sent home requesting instrument choice and was in fact a contract with Long & McQuaid.

To date, some parents have been reluctant to send in the original \$25 and/or the application form for the instruments. We waited until the end of October but have now sent in all forms to the Board as well as to Long and McQuaid to get the program into place.

This requires the Board to let us know what instructors are available as well as have instruments sent. The music program will hopefully start within the next month. I will let you know as soon as details have been finalized.

Next year we hope to have everything back to normal.
