To: Seniors

Re: Senior Pictures for Yearbook

A number of you have asked about specifications and deadlines for yearbook Senior portraits. We need to have your picture on or before **January 16, 2009**. As it often takes several weeks to schedule photos and get finished prints back, you need to plan ahead.

You may have your portrait done by the photographer of your choice. Most studios will provide you with a photo for the yearbook as part of the package. Please inform your photographer that your yearbook portrait should be to the following specifications. You may order whatever you like for your own use, but for the yearbook you should follow these specifications. Photos not meeting these criteria may not be used or may be cropped to meet the standards! If we do not receive a picture from you, we will use your school picture.

1. **Individual headshots** only, with a 1 to 1 1/4 inch head size. If you submit a scenic photo instead of a headshot, we will simply enlarge it to meet our criteria.
2. **No props please.** In other words, please don't submit a picture of you and your hat, doll, brother, sister, tractor, hunting bow, trombone, teddy bear, baby, dog, gerbil or other items. We want you, not other stuff!
3. **No hats please!** Other than this, you may use any *school suitable* clothing and background. Avoid clothing not allowed by the school dress code. Just because you have worn it to school and gotten away with it does not make it school appropriate. The same standard applies to backgrounds. Check your handbook if you have dress code questions.
4. Color photos are preferable as we are tentatively planning to print Seniors in color. Black and white photos will be printed in black and white.
5. You, or your photographer, may submit photos electronically in either jpeg or tiff formats. Send to: mbritton@sheridan.k12.or.us

If cost is a factor, there are a number of inexpensive places to have your picture taken which do good work, several of them local. See Mr. Britton with further questions.
