## A. Back To Christian Basics

---

1. A widespread Christian movement involving sermons and revivals that emphasized faith in God.

## B. Ministering to the People

---

1. The revivals and sermons focused on the person as a sinner.
2. Ministers urged people to seek forgiveness or face an eternity in Hell.

## C. The Great Awakening and Society

---

1. The movement attracted different classes of people.
2. Women, slaves, and the poor sought comfort in the message of forgiveness.
3. The belief in spiritual equality led people to begin to demand political equality.
4. Revivals became popular places to discuss political & social issues.
