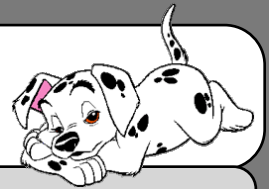




# Ms. Isbell's Little Pup Newsletter

- saying nursery rhymes on the back of this newsletter

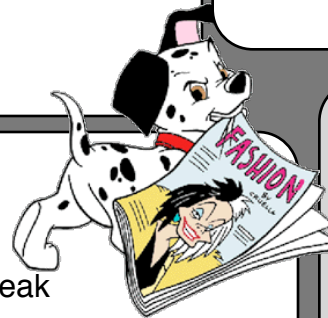
This week on Frogstreet we met:
