Chapter 1

- (7) sensitive (adj.): highly aware and affected by things outside of one's self
syn: emotional ant: insensitive
- (11) rival (n.): the person with whom you are competing; competitor
syn: challenger; opponent ant: partner; friend
- (17) sarcasm (n.): harsh or bitter words that are meant to hurt or make fun of another person
syn: mockery; banter ant: compliment

Chapter 2

- (24) incredulous (adj.): in a state of skepticism, wonder, or disbelief
syn: disbelieving; skeptical ant: believing; gullible
- (29) feud (n.): a long standing argument or fight
syn: fight; grudge ant: harmony; peace

Chapter 3

- (43) bleak (adj.): hopeless; without cheer
syn: grim; wild; bare ant: lush; overgrown
- (42) dumbfounded (adj.): to be confused, amazed, or astonished
syn: stumped; bewildered ant: aware; unsurprised

Chapter 4

- (59) apprehensive (adj.): feeling anxiety about future events
syn: nervous; worried ant: assured; calm; unworried
- (59) defiance (n.): resistance against authority
syn: rebellion; insolence ant: subordination; conformity

- (76) gallant (adj.): brave and dashing
syn: chivalrous; noble ant: cowardly
- (72) imploringly (v.): to beg or plead urgently
syn: entreat; appeal ant: give (?)
