



Cedar Valley MS Daily DOGS Schedule

Dads, if your child is with you when you arrive, you may want to take that opportunity to talk with them about the picture; their lunch time; their preference for the class you observe.

- 7:35-7:45 Check in at the office to receive your Raptor badge. You will need a state-issued ID card or driver's license. The Watch D.O.G.S information folder and vest are located in the Parent Resource Center.
Take picture with your child. (We ask that all dads take a picture, but this is optional for the student.)
- 7:50-8:15 Assist Mrs. Miller or other administrator with student arrival at the cross-walk by the gym. (You may also be asked to assist in other arrival areas.)
- 8:20-8:35 Walk hallways (upstairs and downstairs). Greet students and teachers and encourage students to move to class on time. First period starts at 8:20.
- 8:35-8:45 Return to the office in order to look through the Watch D.O.G.S. folder. Someone will give you a brief orientation, and you may ask questions about the schedule.
- 8:50-9:10 Go by the FLS classrooms (Rms. 1201 & 1239) and help students with their calendar time, reading, or math during first or second period.
- 9:10-9:40 Walk hallways (upstairs and downstairs), around the gym area, and outside by the portables.
- 9:40-10:30 Stop by the Tech Ed classroom (Rm. 1119), visit (and participate if you are able) in the wellness classes in the gym or outside, meet our hall monitor, Susan Andrade, and our School Resource Officer, Danny Colburn, and our lead custodian, Eleanor Alba. Walk the parking lots and the perimeter of the building.
- 10:30-12:30 Monitor the cafeteria. Eat lunch with your child and visit with students in the cafeteria. Encourage students to follow PROWL expectations.
- 12:30-1:30 Monitor the area outside by the portables and blacktop as the 8th graders move to and from lunch.
- 1:30-2:00 Volunteer in the library.
- 2:00-3:00 Monitor the hallways, parking lots, and perimeter of the building.
- 3:00-3:25 Go the Parent Resource Center. Complete the Watch DOGS end-of-day online survey. Leave the information folder in the Parent Resource Center. To find the end of day survey, click on the Watch Dog icon on the CeVMS homepage, and then click on the Watch D.O.G.S. information page.
- 3:25-3:45 Go to the bus lanes and assist with student departure.
- 3:45 Return the vest to the Parent Resource Center. Check out in the office. Thank you for serving as a Watch DOG! We hope you had a great day!
