Test Friday**

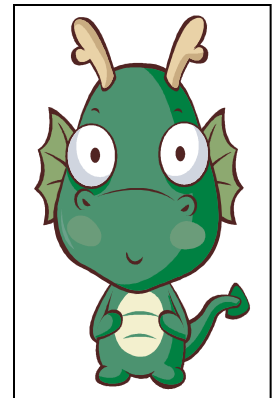
Next week we will be doing a project during class time. Please send a foam poster board and magazines to school with your child by Tuesday (9-29-09)
