~Spelling Tests are on **Wednesdays**. Homework is due on **Tuesdays** (A word list is provided on my website – just in case).

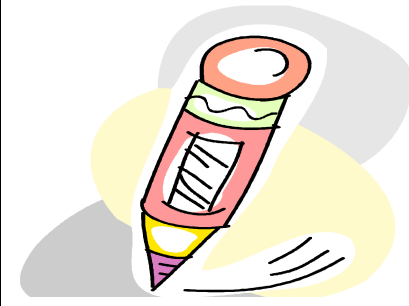
~We will also be going to the library on Friday. I request that the students bring a book to class every day and this is a great time to check something out!

Test Friday

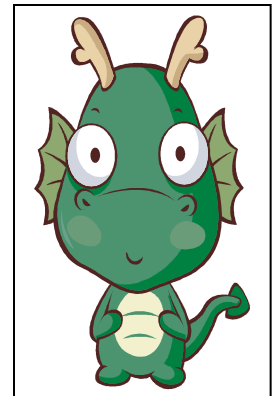
I have sent the website and password for the math book home with your child. If you have any problems with the website let me know and I will issue a math book to your child.
