Green Sheets are considered your daily warm-up. You will have one each week until the end of the school year (they are numbered for you). You are responsible for working on them daily and turning them in on time. The questions/problems on the Green Sheet are ALWAYS BE REVIEW! The level of math will range from basic (elementary & middle school) and Algebra 1 to recent topics taught in your class.

They will be given every Monday (or the first day of the week) @ the beginning of class.

They are due every Friday (or the last day of the week) by the end of class; Points will be deducted for late papers.

Be IN your seat working on it BEFORE the bells rings. Questions can be answered before class or BRIEFLY at the beginning of class. If you need extra help understanding the topic, lunch or afterschool.

Absences: If you miss Monday, you will be given the Sheet your first day back. If you miss Friday, you are responsible for turning it in when you get back (You must write ABSENT on the paper to distinguish it from being late). However, if you do not turn it in AS SOON AS YOU COME BACK TO CLASS, it will be considered late.
