After collecting the above data, our Student Success Committee then put together a set of questions to ask focus groups of randomly selected students in order to get even more data. The Student Success Committee meets again on May 1st to compile this new data collected.

MEAP data was handed out broken down by grade and subjects. MEAPs are taken in the fall so are actually indicative of the previous year.

Mr. Haske mentioned that we have tried holding parent meetings in the evenings in the past and attendance dwindled over time so we have now tried mornings. According to the returned parent surveys, more parents would like to see meetings back in the evenings. We may try doing a combination of mornings and evenings next year.
