Topic Searches in Computer Databases:



CountryWatch

For current country information. Choose your country from the pull-down menu. On the left side is information about the country such as current information on the environment. On the right side is a news wire, an up-to-date brief news source to find current issues.



Sirs Researcher

Good for politics, social issues (human rights, terrorism); not as good for history.

Click on "more issues" under Leading Issues on the right side of the first page to get a list of topics. After selecting a topic, click on Global Impact icon.



ELibrary

A large and current database of articles from newspapers and magazines and websites.

Search multiple keywords, e.g. global warming and France.



Opposing Viewpoints

Keyword search for viewpoint essays, magazines, newspapers, and primary sources; e.g. Immigration France.

Google Search : <http://www.google.com>

Can limit your search results to websites from specific countries by using their country domain abbreviation, e.g. France is FR. Indicate English language results.

Google Search with specific site results:

Type in your search terms, followed by **site:.edu** if you are searching for an academic site source. Example:
immigration policy france site:.edu

OPALS OPAC Library Catalog - Book Resources:

Some books that are part of a series deal with contemporary issues. To find a series in the library catalog, under the **Search menu** select 'series'. Some parts of the book may be global in scope.
