SOME SIMPLE QUESTIONS FOR WRITING REFLECTIONS

Here are some questions that you might want to include when you write a reflection for your individual pieces. This list is **NOT** an outline, so do not feel obligated to follow the questions in order!

- What is your favorite part of this particular piece, and why?
- Are there any weaknesses you see in this piece? Explain.
- What techniques have you tried that differed from your regular process?
- How does this piece compare to other pieces you have written?
- Does this piece connect to any lessons we have done recently?
- What did you find difficult about this piece, and why?
- What really worked in this piece? Why did it seem to work well?
- What is one thing you would like to do to improve the piece, if you only knew how to do it?
- What do you think is the one thing a reader is most likely to take away from your piece?
