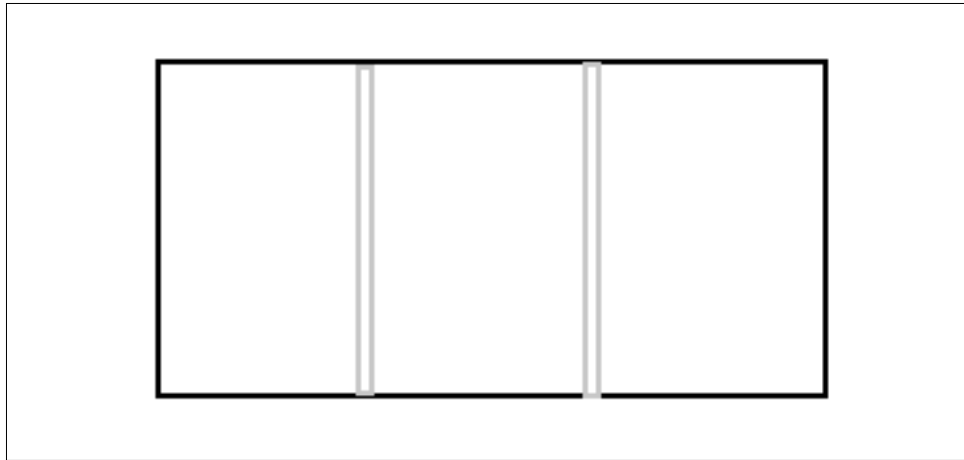


How to Make a Flip Book

Go to AppleWorks- Word Processing.

File to Page Set Up-Click on Landscape.

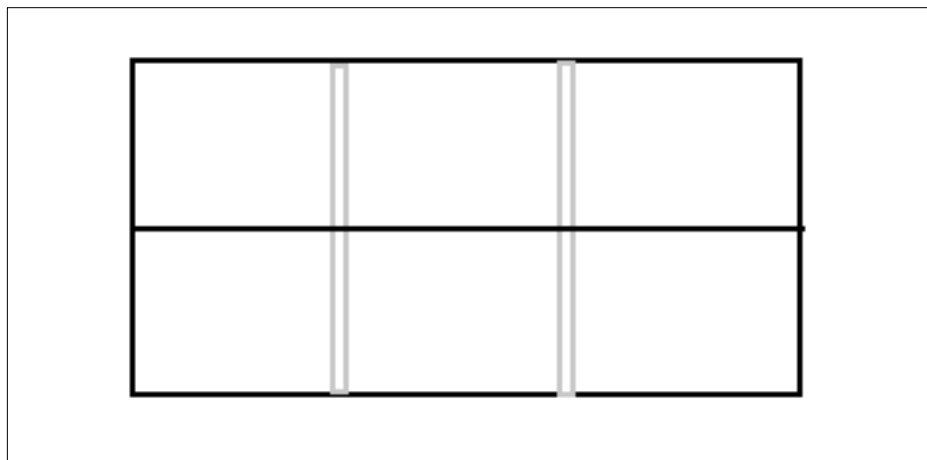
Select the Column Button and and divide the paper into 3 columns.



Go to Windows - Show Rulers and Show Tools.

Select the Line and draw a line in the middle which will be at the 3 inch mark.

You will want to type below the line.



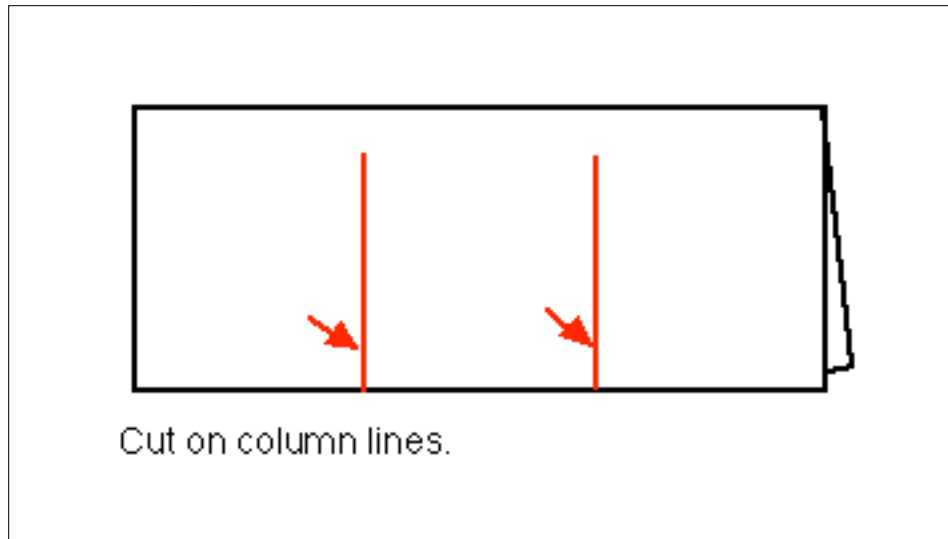
In the first column you type the beginning of a story.

The middle column is for events.

The last column is reserved for endings.

You will want to create several pages.

Take the printed pages and fold them in half.



Cut on the column line. *Make sure you stop about 1/4 inch before the fold. Take a sheet of folded construction paper and staple on the fold to make a cover. The students can flip sections of the book to create unique stories by mixing and matching the beginnings, events and conclusions.
