Exam Study Guide

Your exam consists of three components: an objective (multiple choice) test, a written essay, and an oral discussion.

Objective Test (100) – during regularly scheduled exam period

The objective test consists of the entire level 4 National German Examination administered annually by the AATG. The 100 questions on this comprehensive examination include a listening section with stories and conversational rejoinders and an extensive reading and grammar section.

Mündliche Prüfung (18) – in advance of exam period

You will answer three of the directed response questions used in previous AP exams. These are very general questions that assess your general conversational ability, and will not require specific vocabulary per se.

Essay (26) – in advance of exam period

You will be given a choice of two topics about which to write a well-organized essay of approximately one page. Both topics will require considerable use of the subjunctive mood. (Wenn ich Präsident wäre, würde ich) etc. Dictionaries and notes will not be allowed. Helpful vocabulary is listed below:
